



CODE OF CONDUCT

TEACHERS/COACHES/VOUNTEERS **SWIMMER/WATER POLO PLAYERS**

- Personal conduct must at all times be of a high standard and reflect favourably on the sport and the club.
- Foul and abusive language in public is not acceptable. Language must always be appropriate and socially acceptable.
- Consumption of alcohol is totally forbidden for athletes under age as defined by UK law. It must not be consumed by swimmers or water polo players whilst en route, prior or following a competition event, training camp or team activities, without specific consent of the Team Manager.
During competition alcohol is strictly forbidden for all swimmers and staff.
- Smoking is not allowed by swimmers and water polo players whilst en route, prior to, during or following a competition event, training session or team activities.
- Swimmers and water polo players shall display the required standard of personal appearance at all times. Team kit and equipment shall be worn as directed by the Team Manager when competing and training, when assembling or travelling, at official team functions or on other occasions as notified.
- Swimmers and water polo players are strictly prohibited from taking illegal, performance enhancing drugs and substances. Swimmers and water polo players are expected to be aware of the current list of banned substances. Any person taking medication must ensure that this medication is not on the banned substance list.
- All members must comply with the codes, rules and policies of the club at all times.
- All members should treat other competitors/teams/officials with respect in victory or defeat.
- All members to obey the “spirit of the rules and laws” both in and out of the pool.
- Encourage all members of the club to accept decisions made by officials whether at club level or from an outside organisation.
- Ensure that all members who are representing the club do so in a professional manner in accordance with A.S.A guidelines.
